# Eungella Dam Camping Rules

## Camp site

- Camp in the designated areas only as private property adjoins the camping area.
- The maximum stay for camping is 28 days.
- Camping is not permitted within five metres of the lake water line.
- Keep your camp tidy and respect your surroundings.
- Be considerate of others – keep noise to a minimum.
- The speed limit in the camping area is 20 km/hour.
- All persons who are registered to camp with this one permit must camp together on one general campsite with their camping structures no more than five metres apart.
- Launch and retrieve boats from the boat ramp.

## Campfires

- Campfires should only be used in a properly constructed area and be fully extinguished prior to leaving.
- Campfires should be kept under strict supervision, at all times.
- Campers must adhere to total fire bans and the fire warning sign.
- Cutting down trees for firewood is strictly prohibited.

## Environment

- Please do not disturb or damage plants and wildlife.
- Do not feed the wildlife.
- Do not use detergents within five metres of the lake water line.

## Motorcycles

- The recreational operation of registered or unregistered motorcycles and four wheelers within the camping area and surrounding private property is strictly prohibited for licensed and unlicensed drivers.

## Pets

- Dogs are allowed but must be kept under strict supervision at all times.
- Pets must be kept on a leash when walking around the campground.

## General behaviour

- All campers are asked to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner.
- Please be considerate of others and neighbouring campsites.
